Sliding Knot Necklaces

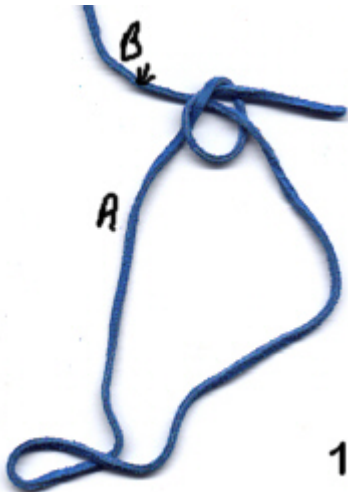
Ingredients

- 60cm – 1m of cord, leather or ribbon
- Your bead, pendant, charm
- 1 large seed beads or congos for ends if desired

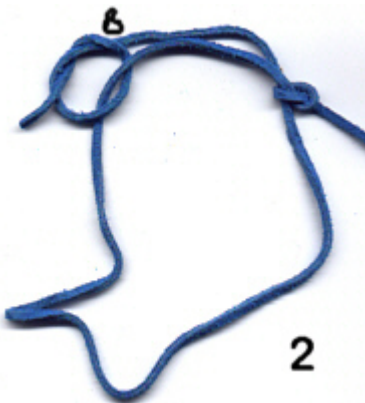
Recipe

Slide your bead/pendant/charm into the middle of the cord.

1. Take your length of cord, and tie a simple overhand (granny) knot around one side (B) of the cord with the other side (A).



2. Now take B and tie it in the same way around A



3. Tighten both knots. You can now either snip off the excess cord, or thread on a small bead onto the excess and make another knot for a wee feature at the ends..



Now you can slide the knots together for a longer necklace, or pull them further apart for a shorter one.
