

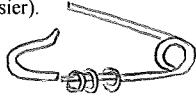

PROJECT OF THE MONTH!  
Kilt Pin

Ingredients

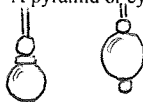
- kilt pin
- 2 packets of 8mm jumprings
- 1 packet of headpins
- 1 packet of 3/4mm jumprings
- 25cm fine/medium chain
- 10-15 feature beads
- charms if desired
- spacers/washers/bead caps

Recipe

1. Open each of the 8mm jumprings and attach them onto the kilt pin (two pairs of chain nose pliers can make this easier).



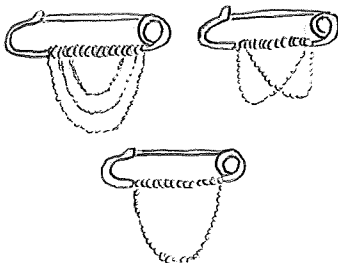
2. Thread your beads onto headpins, frame with spacers or washers. A pyramid or eye shape works well.



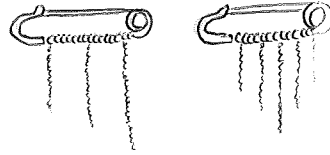
3. Cut the headpin 1cm above the bead and make a lollipop loop using round nose pliers.

4. Attach the chain to the kilt pin by opening the 8mm jumprings and threading on the chain link. The chain can be attached to form loops or drops.

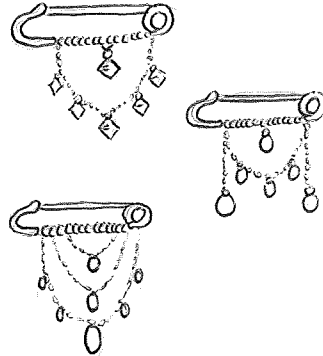
Drops



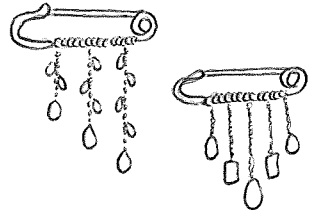
5. Using the 3/4mm jumprings attach your bead sets to the chain.
