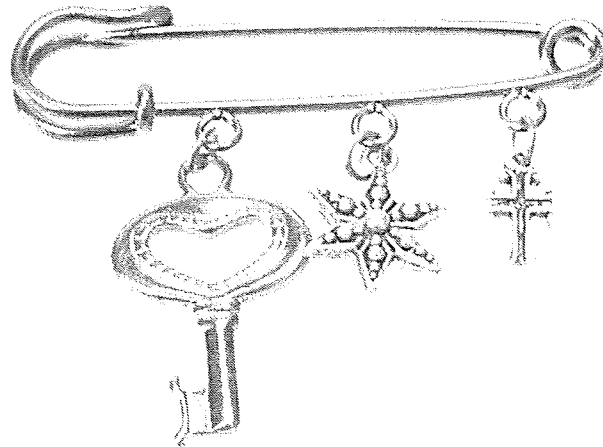


MAY PROJECT

- Charm Pin -



INGREDIENTS

- A kilt pin with 3 loops
- Three charms, 1 x large, 1 x medium, 1 x small
- 3 4mm jumprings

TECHNIQUE

OPENING AND CLOSING JUMPRINGS

Your **ACTION** hand is your dominant hand

Your **ROCK** hand is your other hand

1. Take a jumpring, and find the opening. Imagine the jumpring is a clock face. The opening should be at 12 o'clock.
2. Take your chain nose pliers in your ROCK hand. Grip them at 9 o'clock on the jumpring.
3. Take your other pliers in your ACTION hand, and grip them at 3 o'clock on the jumpring.
4. Open the jumpring toward or away from you, on a straight line. Do not pull it to the side to open, as the shape will be distorted.
5. Put down the pliers in your action hand, and hook the jumpring into those things that need linking.
6. Take up your pliers in your action hand again, and close the jumpring tight. Keep your rock hand still and steady, and use your action hand to close the jumpring. You may need to wiggle that side of the jumpring back and forth a little with gentle inward pressure to get it closed tightly.

The jumpring needs to be closed tightly with no overlapping of the edges, and no gap.

RECIPE

Use your jumprings to attach each charm to a loop on the kilt pin.
